Question	Information, Advice and Guidance
<p>What grade of member do I need to be to apply for ELEnv?</p>	<p>There are a variety of membership levels used by our Licensed Members, but for clarification speak to your professional body.</p>
<p>Do I need to have done a specific course or qualification?</p>	<p>There is the requirements of showing evidence of a qualification at a minimum of RQF level 2 (or equivalent). This is to demonstrate sufficient environmental knowledge. The Licensed Member can identify if your qualification meets that requirement.</p>
<p>Have I got to sign the SocEnv Code of Professional Conduct as well as my professional body's Code of Conduct?</p>	<p>Yes, you need to sign and comply with both.</p>
<p>Do I need to do CPD (Continuous Professional Development) as part of being an ELEnv registrant?</p>	<p>CPD is not mandatory for ELEnv, however it is for CEnv, REnvP and REnvTech. so it's a good idea to get used to planning and recording your CPD activity. Your Professional Body can advise of CPD requirements for membership.</p>
<p>What is the time-limit on for gaining the appropriate amount of practical experience?</p>	<p>You can be an ELEnv registrant for up to three years, which should be ample time to gain the experience you need to transition to REnvTech, REnvP or CEnv.</p>
<p>How much does it cost?</p>	<p>ELEnv initial registration and ongoing annual renewal fees will be charge by, and paid to, your chosen Licensed Member.</p> <p>Fees charged vary between each Licensed Member. This is because SocEnv charges each Licensed Member a set amount for each ELEnv registrant they have – the Licensed Member then has the option to add appropriate administration and processing fees to meet their financial needs.</p> <p>Fees charged can typically be found through the Licensed Member website. Most are also available to view in the Licensed Member section of our website, here.</p>
<p>My professional body does not offer ELEnv. What are my options?</p>	<p>You have two options: you can look through our current Licensed Members and choose a suitable professional body to join as a secondary membership - just make sure they offer ELEnv, as this</p>

<p>Can I apply for ELEnv in my country?</p>	<p>will allow you to apply for ELEnv registration through them. Alternatively, you can explore whether your existing professional body might become a new Licensed Member with SocEnv, or add ELEnv to their current licences. We're more than happy to support you with this, so please do get in touch if you'd like to take this forward.</p> <p>Yes, you can apply from anywhere in the world. 18% of current registrants are based outside of the UK, with registrants located in over 97 countries. You will be joining a global community of professionals tackling environmental challenges and moving towards a more sustainable future.</p>
<p>Can I transfer my registration to another Licensed Member?</p>	<p>Generally, yes. You can transfer your ELEnv registration to another Licensed Member at no cost, but you must meet the new Member's requirements. Contact your current Licensed Member to request the transfer.</p>
